• Adventure Africa

An adventure through Africa exploring traditional tales, drumming and dance.

## • Ancient Egyptians (for KS2)

We're on the hunt of King Tutankhamen's murderer! Through investigations of the ancient pyramids and deciphering hieroglyphics you can help us find the villain.

## • Ancient Olympics

It's 776 BC and we're in the Greek city of Olympia. Welcome to the first ever Olympics! Compere in a variety of performing arts activities to see which city comes out on top.

#### • Ancient theatre (for KS2)

Travel back in time to explore the origin of theatre through mask and chorus work while learning about classic Greek mythology.

#### • Awesome Australia

Delve into the Australian Outback through aboriginal stories and songs, and venture across the landscape.

#### • Britain at war – WWII (for KS2)

Going back to the time of the Blitz, we explore what it was like to be a child during the second world war.
